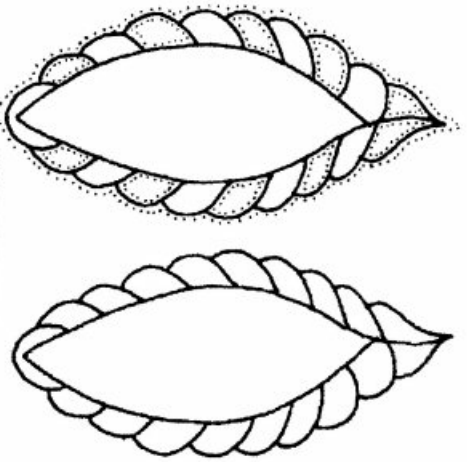
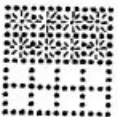


# 3D BUTTERFLY

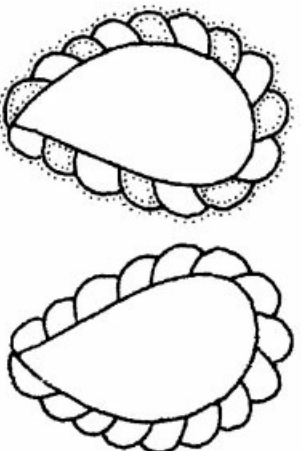
## MAIN BUTTERFLY (LEFT AND RIGHT WINGS)



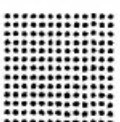
WING SET 1



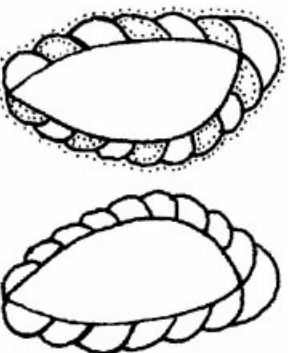
Grid pattern for wing set number 1  
From the back of the work emboss with the sun tool and emboss a small dot in the centre with the stylus.



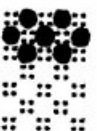
WING SET 3



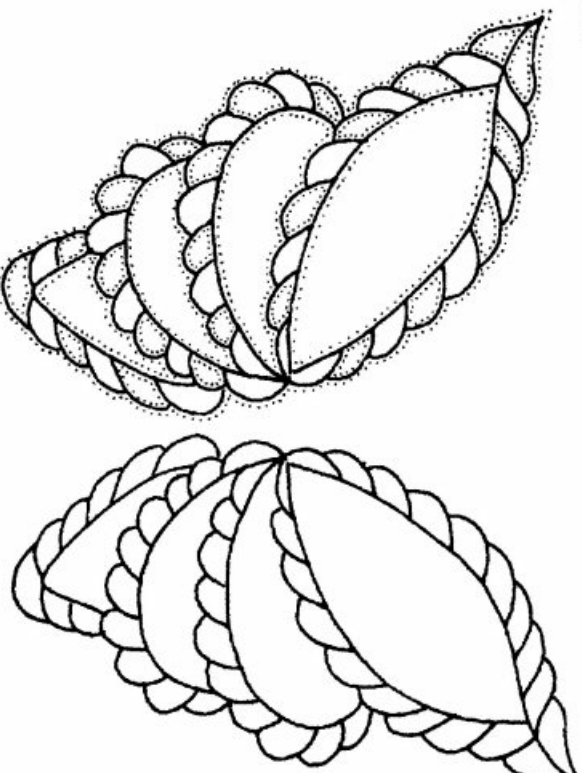
Grid pattern for wing set number 3  
This is simply every hole pieced but without any embossing.



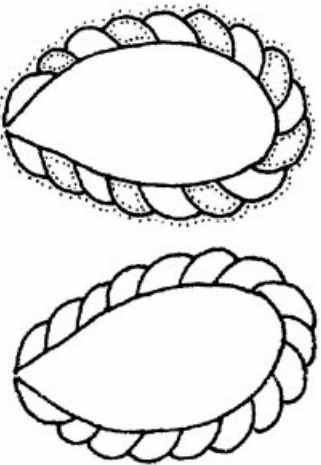
WING SET 4



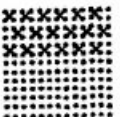
Grid pattern for wing set number 4  
Emboss between each and every cross. (Known as the basic dot and cross.)



All the entire wing centres on the main butterfly are pieced with a 2 in 2 needle and then snipped out.



WING SET 2



Grid pattern for wing set number 2  
Cut every alternative cross with scissors or snips. The next row is done in the same way but in between the row above. ( see finished butterfly)
